APPLICATION

Define "Community Service": Students are asked to complete a simple application requesting student information including GPA, and design an advertising campaign or submit an essay, 500 words or less, that represents their idea of community service. Ads may be created free-hand or electronically and becomes the property of the Bank for possible future advertising.

References: Students must provide two community or educational references.

Qualifications: A minimum 2.5 GPA and a record of good standing in the school and community is required to qualify for the scholarship award.

SELECTION

Timeline: All applications must be received by April 15th.

Process: A regional bank advisory board will review the submitted applications and select the award recipient. Student will be selected based on concept of community service as well as quality of references and community involvement.

RECOGNITION

Award: The Bank will award one \$500.00 scholarship to the selected student along with a certificate of recognition to be presented to the student during the school's award ceremony. The student is responsible for submitting school information to the Bank. We will send the scholarship check directly to the school along with a letter on behalf of the student. Each student will receive an award packet with instructions at time of certificate presentation.

Media Recognition: The selected student may be featured in the local newspaper and media with their winning community advertisement or essay. Ads may also be used in the program advertisement for the following year and may appear on flyers, posters, and print advertising.
